## 2009 Policy on Cell Phones

**Cell phones are a great way to keep in touch while away from home but they are often a distraction to the real purpose of our travel. Players will be allowed to take cell phones on the road only under the following guidelines:**

1. Coaches have been given the cell #.
2. Players use phones as directed by the coaches.
3. Phones are turned off:
  - for pre and post game team meetings
  - during the pre game rides to the gym
  - during game preparation, warm-ups
  - during the games.
4. **Absolutely NO TALKING** on cell phones during games!!!!!!!
5. Players are not to use phones after designated bedtime.  
This is discourteous to roommates and does not allow players to get the rest needed for competition.

On occasion, phones may be taken up temporarily overnight to insure that players sleep well - especially on the nights before early AM games. Players will be given the chance to call to tell parents this is the case.

### **\*\*\* IMPORTANT NOTE\*\*\***

Misuse of a cell phone may result in the phone's being confiscated by the coaches for the rest of the trip

## Parent Responsibilities

By your son's agreeing to accept a place on a Skillz Choice team, your family is agreeing to place a high value on their commitment to the goals of the program. This includes the obligation for the players to attend regularly the practices and clinics provided for them as well attending as other team activities such as SAT Prep. It is the responsibility of the parent/parents to provide transportation for the player to the practices, in-town games, etc., and to meeting locations for travel. If you cannot provide transportation for your son to any team event, then it is your responsibility to arrange help from another source such as another team member. Each player will receive a team roster to facilitate contacting other team families. We also ask that you support the requirement that he call the coach in advance if he will be unable to attend any scheduled practice or event. His participation on the team is another opportunity for him to learn how to handle his commitments in life and how to be a responsible member of a group.

Your son's coaches have the duty to conduct themselves as mature and responsible adults at all times. Both coaches and parents should always remember that the Skillz Choice Basketball Program is a developmental program with the goals of having all players make progress in basketball and of helping all the young men become more mature persons. Losing games is never pleasant or desirable - for coaches, players, or fans. However, when parents are critical of the efforts of the players and/or coaches, the effect on the players is at best a distraction and at worst undermines the goals of the program. Our coaches have the best interest of ALL the players in mind. Parents are asked to be positive and cheer on every member of the team - all kids are in need of encouragement in life and you could make a real difference to one of them. Good sportsmanship is not just for the court - coaches and parents alike should set, a good example at all times. Many tournaments hold coaches/teams responsible for the conduct of their fans. All tournaments retain the right to eject players, coaches, and fans that are out of line - usually at the discretion of the officials.

As a parent, you want the best for your son. Likewise, our Skillz Choice coaches want the best for him. We ask parents to refrain from coaching their child in practices and during games - no matter how basketball knowledgeable and experienced they might be. It is always uncomfortable to attempt to talk over an aggressive, coaching parent. It is also a shame for a coach to need to remove a player from a game because he is acting upon his parent's instructions rather than fulfilling the expectations of the team and his coaches. Any parent questions concerning coaching should be discussed with the coach in private, without players present. During practices we rely on parental support and may ask parents to assist with overseeing the practice or to leave the gym if players seem distracted by the parents' presence. When observing in the gym we ask that you keep conversation to a level that does not distract from instructions being given on the court.

Almost everyone assisting with the Skillz Choice program is a volunteer; the coaches are here because they care about young men and they have a great deal of experience working with youth. If you have specific concerns about your son, please feel free to discuss them with the coaches. They will be happy to try to assist you with any areas you are working on with him at home.

## 2009 Player Travel agreement

1. I will obey all laws, statues, rules, regulations, and polices of whatever state, hotel, restaurant, transport Gymnasium, school, or any other public place I visit.
2. I will willingly comply with all rules and regulations set by the coaches. I will be in the appointed places in a prompt and orderly fashion and I will honor all curfew and room limitations. I will stay in the room assigned to me on each trip.
3. I will not use any alcoholic beverage, illegal drug, or any other illegal substance **AT ANY TIME**. (This includes cigarettes.) I will not bring weapons of any kind on tournament trips.
4. I will exhibit good sportsmanship both on and off the basketball court and strive to reflect positively on my team at all times.
5. I will not ride in the car with, or be in the hotel room of, anyone other than one of my coaches, a Skillz Choice team member or the parent/family of a Skillz Choice team member at any time.
6. I will not have anyone who is not a player, parent/ family, or coach associated with the Skillz Choice Basketball Team in my hotel room at any time without the specific permission of the coaches.
7. I will not leave my assigned hotel room after curfew for any reason without the specific Permission of the coaches. I will **observe quiet hours** in the hotel's hallways & in the rooms.
8. I will never swim alone: I will have at least two (2) Skillz Choice players or family members with me whenever I go to a hotel pool. If I cannot swim well, I should not go into the pool without an adult escort present.
9. I will not damage any hotel room or hotel property. I will use the room telephones and hotel services in the manner indicated in this agreement or as instructed by the coaches.
10. I will not use the telephone in my room to make any calls other than to the room of another Skillz Choice player, parent/family, or coach. All other local, room to room, or long distance calls must have the permission of the coaches. (There are fees even for local calls made from hotel rooms and also connection fees for long distance calls made by calling card.)
11. I will not charge any movies, games, food, or anything else to my room without the prior permission of the coaches.

**Players' Families will be held responsible for misuse of phones, unauthorized room charges, and property damage.**

12. I will be responsible for the Skillz Choice team uniforms and gear issued to me and return them to the coach at the requested time in good condition.

**If any part of my uniform is not turned in, I/my parents will be required to pay for it to be replaced or, if that cannot be done, pay \$250.00 toward the replacement of the team's uniforms.**

I understand that violating any of these or other rules of the Skillz Choice Basketball Team or the instructions of the coaches could result in my being benched for one or more games, **dropped from the team, or sent home early from a trip at the expense of my family.**

## 2009 Playing Time Policy

On an "ALL STAR" summer team, the playing time issue is different than it is on a school team. Usually, EVERY player on the Skillz Choice team is a "STAR" at his own school and has been chosen to play on the team because he has something specific to contribute. The number of players on the team is 12 or 13. We must carry that number to be able to withstand fouling out, injuries, and illness during tournaments when playing up to 4 games per day and to allow us to have as many different types of players as possible. We have deliberately selected players that are different from one another so that no matter what type of team we play against we can attempt to match up well. There may be games where you don't play much and other games where you play a lot because you match up well or are having a particularly good game.

You can be assured that the coaches are concerned that all players get to play and that **NO** player has been promised a primary roll as happens on some teams. The BEST player for the situation will be on the floor so long as he is giving his BEST effort. It is to EVERYONE'S advantage for the team to win as many games as possible so we can advance to play more games and it is up to the coaches to determine how best to do that. **MORE GAMES = MORE PLAYING TIME FOR THE WHOLE TEAM TO DIVIDE/SHARE.**

If you wish to discuss your playing time or other issues you may certainly come to the coach in private. DO NOT bring them up during a game. **Any player who exhibits disrespectful behavior can expect to be benched for a period of time. Repeated incidents will suit in being dropped from the team.**

**BOTTOM LINE:** Playing time is at the discretion of the coaches. All players are expected to follow any instructions given by the coaches, play with intensity, and improve their game over the course of the season.

**PLEASE NOTE:** Playing time may also be affected by absences - even excused absences - and by a player's attitude or work ethic in practice.

## 2009 "Rules of the Road"

We are very happy to have parents & families join us on road trips. Here are some guidelines that will help things run smoothly "on the road." Your cooperation will be appreciated. Communication is the key to avoiding problems.

- Players are required to stay at the hotel **with the team** while still playing in the tournament. Only players or coaches are allowed to stay in team rooms.
- Players must be on time for departure for team activities or travel.
- Players are NEVER to leave the gym before the post-game team meeting which immediately follows **every** game. Each player is responsible for finding out when and where the team is to meet for the next game.
- Players cannot leave the hotel or a game - even with their own parents **without getting permission** from the team's **head** coach **in person**. We encourage the parents to let the players remain with the team as much as possible as this helps team camaraderie.
- If a player is to be allowed to leave the hotel or a game with a relative other than a parent, the coach must have the **written** approval of the parent stating the person's name and relationship to the player. They may need to show ID. A player must check out with the coach **every time he leaves the team or the hotel – even with his parent(s)**.
- Anyone who takes a player away from the team should be made aware of the Skillz Choice policies by the player and/or his parents.
- Players not on time or present for team meetings & activities may be benched for one or more games.
- Parents who are driving players other than their own are to refrain from drinking alcohol when they will be driving players other than their own child.
- Parents are asked not to take players out after curfew unless permission is gotten from the coach.
- Skillz Choice parents and fans are asked to demonstrate good sportsmanship toward referees and the opponents' players and fans as an example for the players. At many tournaments the coach is held responsible for the behavior of his team's fans.

## 2009 Team Policies

**Players & Parents should go over this carefully together before signing.**

1. Players are expected to make a **serious commitment to being on the team** - attending tournaments, practices & clinics. The dates of the tournaments are available well in advance - please go over them upon receipt and notify the coach **immediately** if there are any problems.
2. Parents are responsible for providing or arranging transportation for their son to all team activities. You will have a roster so you can ask for help when needed.
3. ANTICIPATE conflicts & problems by looking ahead & then let coaches know in advance of problems/conflicts in writing. Players are to notify the coach as soon as possible when they will be unable to attend any scheduled practice or event.  
**NEVER, EVER be a "No Show"!**  
**NOTE: Absences - even when excused - can affect a player's playing time.**
4. Players should arrive ON TIME for practices & games & at locations required for travel to out-of-town tournaments.
5. Players/Parents are asked to provide any paperwork needed in a timely manner. Players without completed paperwork cannot travel.
6. Players are to read & comply with Rules of the Road; the Travel Agreement rules, guidelines, & curfews & the Policy on Cell Phones.
7. **PLAYERS ARE STRONGLY ENCOURAGED TO WEAR ANKLE BRACES FOR GAMES & PRACTICE**

- **NOT** notifying, the coach of absences before the fact,
- **NOT** attending practices or tournaments **regularly**,
- **NOT** following team rules and guidelines on the road,
- Or who persistently exhibit an attitude which is not in keeping with team spirit, good sportsmanship, or respect for the coaches or others

### Travel Checklist

PLAYERS MUST BRING THE FOLLOWING:

- In case of illness or injury, **MEDICAL INSURANCE & PRESCRIPTION CARD OR INFORMATION** - a **copy** of both front & back of card is preferred so we can keep that in our tournament notebook all summer. A list of any allergies to medications or other pertinent health information should be on your Medical Info.
- **PRESCRIPTION MEDICATION** if needed, with instructions for use and in original containers from pharmacy.
- **EXTRA CONTACT LENSES OR GLASSES** - you should always carry these in your game bag so they are with you - we suggest 2 extra pairs for a trip.
- **MONEY** for food, recreation, & for any shopping/tournament gear you may want (**NO LESS THAN \$25 TO \$30 PER DAY FOR FOOD** - coaches are encouraged to make use of the complimentary breakfasts available at some hotels). Coaches are asked NOT to loan money to the players - money spent is the parent's choice.
- **SKILLZ CHOICE BAG TO TAKE TO THE GYM** - If you bring a ball, please be sure it is well marked with your name! You should always have your money with you - in your Skillz Choice bag or in your pocket. **DO NOT LEAVE YOUR BELONGINGS UNATTENDED!!! DO NOT** leave money in the hotel room unless you put it in a room safe which is provided in some of the hotels.
- **WRAPS, TAPE, BRACES, MOUTH GUARD, ETC. FOR YOURSELF** Skillz Choice will provide for **new** injuries incurred on the trip but you must provide for your **customary** use of these items. **ALL PLAYERS SHOULD HAVE & WEAR ANKLE BRACES.**
- **LONG DISTANCE CALLING CARD IF YOU DON'T HAVE A CELL.**  
**NOTE:** No long distance phone calls are to be made from the rooms as many hotels charge a fee even for calling card connection. The calling card can be used at public phones. No local calls should be made from the rooms without Coach's permission as there is a charge made by the hotel for them as well. **Player's families will be held responsible for unauthorized use of phones.**
- **Book(s) to read - "SUMMER READING"** (Never too early to get it done!)
- **WALKMAN/DISCMAN** &/or handheld video games, playing cards, dominoes, etc.
- **CLOTHES & TOILETRIES - BATHING SUIT.**

**PLEASE MARK ALL PERSONAL ITEMS WITH YOUR NAME** so they will not be mixed up with your roommates' things.

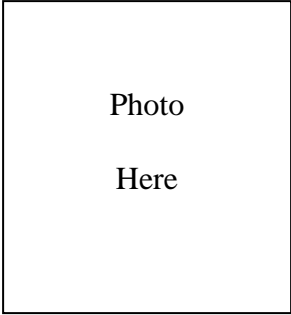
